The venue is at Black Ven Farm, Nutley in Sussex. The shoot is in undulating meadows bordered by thick hedges and trees. A dense wood runs along one side and the ground's dimensions lend themselves perfectly for a couple of flight rounds as part of the event.

On the M25, take Junction 6, A22 Dir. Eastbourne. Continue on the A22, via East Grinstead and on through the Ashdown Forest until Nutley. In Nutley turn right into Nether Lane, opposite the shop – you should see our target sign. Nether Lane leads you to Down Street. Follow Down Street; the shoot is opposite the Farm which will be on your left.
