The 7th Baron Camoys Shoot: 8 – 9 February 2020 at the Marks, at Speed and in the Cloth of Gold

Stonor Park is open to the longbow. Set in a dramatic sweeping valley deep within the Chiltern Hills, the ancestral home of the Stonor family offers superlative shooting ground steeped in history for the traditional longbow archer.

The first Baron of Camoys fought alongside King Henry V at the Battle of Agincourt.

The shoot is by kind permission of the present Baron Camoys.

Stonor Park is located two-thirds of the way London to Oxford between the M4 and the M40.

It is easily reached from the North and West via M40 jct 5, Stokenchurch.

From the West, M4 jct 13. From the South and East M4 jct 8/9, then A404 and A4130 via Henley on Thames. London is 1 hr. 20 mins, Heathrow is 45 mins. Luton is 1 hr.
