The Viscount Harcourt Shoot: 24 – 25 August 2024 to the Marks, at Speed and in the Cloth of Gold

Cokethorpe Estate is open to the longbow. Set on the site of a once medieval village, the ancestral home of the Lovell family offers superlative shooting ground steeped in history for the traditional longbow archer. Lord Francis Lovell escaped the Battle of Bosworth field in 1485 but his body was found walled up at Minster Lovell some years later.

The shoot is by kind permission of the school that now resides at this site.

Cokethorpe Estate is between the A40 and A420 in Oxfordshire on the A415.

It is easily reached from the M40 JCT 9, A34 southbound from the North.

From the M4 JCT 13, A34 from the South.

From the West, M4 JCT 15, A419.

From the East, M4 JCT 15, A419.
